**INFORMATION FOR THIRD PARTIES**

**INTRODUCTORY INFORMATION**

Dear website visitors,

This Data Privacy Policy is intended to inform you of the manner in which **Pierre Baguette s. r. o.**, with its registered office at Veľkouľanská 1716/9, 925 21 Sládkovičovo, Company ID No.: 36 255 220, registered in the Commercial Register of the District Court Trnava, Section Sro, File No. 14215/T (hereinafter referred to as the "**Company**" or the "**Controller**" or "**PB SK**"), processes your personal data when you send an inquiry through the contact form on the Company's website in accordance with applicable legal regulations, with particular emphasis on Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter as the "**Regulation**" or "**GDPR**").

Personal data are understood to mean information relating to a specific person who can be identified on the basis of this information, or in connection with other information.

With regard to the possibility for any third parties to send an inquiry to the Company during a visit to the PB SK website, all third parties who voluntarily decide to send an inquiry or a message to PB SK via the contact form available on the PB SK website are considered data subjects (hereinafter as "**data subjects**" or also as "**third parties**").

In case you are not acting as a third party, but are an employee of the Company, a business partner of the Company, a participant in a competition announced by the Company, or an applicant for employment at the Company, your personal data are processed on a different legal basis and for a different purpose than those set forth in this Data Privacy Policy below.

### Who is the controller of your personal data?

The data controller is **Pierre Baguette s. r. o.**, with its registered office at Velkoúľanská 1716/9, 925 21 Sládkovičovo, company registration number 36 255 220, registered in the Commercial Register of the District Court Trnava, Section Sro, Insert No. 14215/T, which determines the manner and purpose for which personal data of data subjects are processed.

### What personal data of yours do we process, for what purpose and on what legal basis?

The table below sets out what personal data, for what reason and for what purpose PB SK processes regarding data subjects.

### From what sources do we obtain your personal data?

The Company obtains the personal data that it subsequently processes directly from you. The personal data you provide are obtained via the completion of the contact form on the PB SK website: <https://pierrebaguette.com/pl/pl>

### Will your personal data be used for automated individual decision-making?

The Controller does not carry out automated decision-making (including profiling) when processing your personal data.

### Do we share your data with other persons? Who are the other recipients of your personal data?

The Company, in handling your inquiry, may use the services of external service providers, who mainly provide IT, marketing and promotion, and legal advisory services. Such external service providers are vetted by the Company and provide sufficient guarantees with respect to the confidentiality and protection of the personal data of data subjects. In such a case, the Company enters into a written data processing agreement with the relevant external service provider, whereby the provider undertakes to protect personal data and to comply with the Company's standards for personal data security.

The Company is obliged, under certain circumstances, to share the personal data of data subjects with third parties other than the above-mentioned service providers, in accordance with legal regulations on the protection of personal data. Such third parties include, in particular, administrative and similar authorities (tax offices), financial institutions (banks, insurance companies), the police and public prosecutor's offices.

### **Do we intend to transfer your personal data to a third country or an international organization outside the EEA?**

The personal data of data subjects will not be transferred to a third country or an international organization outside the EEA.

### **How long will we retain your personal data?**

The Company retains the personal data of data subjects only for the period necessary to fulfil the purpose. In particular, your personal data will be processed for the period required to handle your inquiry and any subsequent operations to be performed in connection with your inquiry, but no longer than for a period of 2 years from the granting of consent, unless the granted consent is revoked prior to the expiration of such period.

If the inquiry concerns a contractual relationship between you and PB SK, the legal basis is the performance of such contract. Your inquiry may be retained only for the period necessary to fulfil the purpose, but no longer than until the termination of the contractual relationship between you and PB SK.

### **What are your rights regarding the processing of personal data?**

In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have, in accordance with the GDPR, in particular the right to:

- the **right to access** personal data and to obtain further information related to their processing by the Controller or processors, including a copy of the personal data that the Controller holds about the data subject;
- the **right to rectification** of inaccurate and incomplete personal data;
- the **right to erasure** of personal data, in particular if (i) they are no longer necessary for further processing for the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed; (ii) consent to their processing has been withdrawn and there is no other legal basis for their processing; (iii) the data subject has legitimately objected to their processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for processing, or processing has been objected to pursuant to Article 21(2) of the GDPR; (iv) they have been processed unlawfully; or (v) they must be erased to comply with a legal obligation under legal regulations;
- **the right to restriction** of processing of personal data, if (i) the data subject contests the accuracy of the personal data for a period enabling the Controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data; (ii) the processing is unlawful and the data subject objects to the erasure of the personal data and requests instead the restriction of its use; (iii) the Controller no longer needs the personal data for the given purpose of processing, but the data subject requires the personal data for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims; or (iv) the data subject has objected to its processing pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR, pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of the Controller override those of the data subject;
- **the right to object** to the processing of personal data in the event that they are processed for the purposes of the legitimate interests of the Controller. The Controller

may no longer process the personal data unless it demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests or rights and freedoms of the data subject, or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims. If you raise an objection to further processing for the purposes of direct marketing, the personal data will not be further processed for these purposes;

- **the right to obtain your personal data and transfer the data** to another controller upon fulfilment of statutory conditions, if the personal data was processed based on consent, a contract, or if the processing is carried out by automated means;
- **the right to withdraw the granted consent** for personal data processing at any time (if consent to the processing of personal data was granted), without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent prior to its withdrawal, by mail, email, or in person at our address provided below in the "Questions and Contacts" section;
- **the right to lodge a complaint** with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland (*Prezes Urzędu Ochrony Danych Osobowych*), with its registered office at Moniuszki 1A street, 00-014 Warsaw, if you believe that the Controller is violating obligations arising from the legal regulations on personal data protection.

Providing your personal data is voluntary. However, in the absence of personal data, processing of your request (inquiry) may be limited.
